## Notice to the Bar and the Public

**Re: Conversion to CM/ECF Release 3.1**

**Our court will be converting to CM/ECF release 3.1. on October 13, 2006.** The system will be offline beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 13, 2006. Access will be restored on or before 7:00 a.m. on Monday, October 16, 2006.

This mandatory conversion addresses the statistical requirements of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act and the Judicial Conference's Committee on the Administration of the Bankruptcy System. Significant changes have been incorporated into the case opening processes of release 3.1 that will not permit the filing of a bankruptcy petition utilizing software that is not compatible with release 3.1.


Filers using bankruptcy preparation software are encouraged to advise their respective provider of the court's scheduled migration to release 3.1. By providing these vendors with advanced notification of the court's scheduled upgrade, they will be in a better position to provide users with the necessary updates for continued successful electronic filing over the internet with the court. **However, preparation software modified for version 3.1 CANNOT be used with version 3.0 and prior to October 16, 2006.**
