
In Re: AMENDMENT TO REAFFIRMATION DOCUMENTS

The Administrative Office Director's reaffirmation forms have been revised, **effective December 1, 2009**, to consist of Form B240A (called the "Reaffirmation Documents," a package of five form documents, including the agreement itself, the statutory disclosures and other documents), Form B240B ("Motion for Approval of Reaffirmation Agreement"), and Form B240C ("Order on Reaffirmation Agreement"). The goal of the revision is to make it easier for debtors and creditors to understand how the forms should be completed and, as a result, to reduce errors.

The Bankruptcy Rules Committee has suggested a six-month transitional period, beginning December 1, 2009, during which both the existing and revised forms may be used. During the transition, both the old and new versions of the forms will be posted on the Judiciary's website at http://www.uscourts.gov/bkforms/bankruptcy_forms.html#procedure.
