Re: Pay.gov Security Enhancement

Beginning February 1, 2007, Pay.gov will validate the security code with the credit card number supplied by the attorney. The security code is the three-digit number that generally appears on the back of a credit card in the account holder signature box. However with American Express, it is a 4 digit code on the front of the card.

If the credit card number and security code do not match the values on file with the bank or Pay.gov, the user will receive an error message, such as:"The card security code is invalid, please re-enter the card security code." The receipt of an error message will prevent the attorney from proceeding, unless a correct security code is entered.
