



NOTICE TO THE BAR AND TO THE PUBLIC
In Re: Electronic Public Access Fee Schedule


The Judicial Conference of the United States, at its March 2001 session, approved the creation of a separate Fee Schedule for Electronic Public Access which will become effective July 1, 2001.

The fees to be charged in connection with electronic public access to court records are the following:

- For usage of electronic access to Court data via dial up service: sixty cents per minute
- For obtaining information through a federal judiciary internet site: seven cents per page. This fee will be billed by PACER service center, and is due when an account holder accrues charges of more than \$10.00 in a calendar year.
- For printing copies of any record or document at a public terminal in the Courthouse: ten cents per page. This fee shall apply to services rendered on behalf of the United States if the record requested is remotely available through electronic access.
- For every search of court records conducted by PACER Center: \$20.00. This fee will be billed by the PACER service center whenever they have to provide information to individuals who not have PACER accounts or when they provide support for those experiencing equipment failures.

These fees are effective July 1, 2001.
