IT IS ORDERED that attorneys' fees for debtors' counsel in Chapter 13 cases are allowable, without the necessity of filing a detailed application for compensation, for requests seeking \$350, or less, for legal services performed in connection with post-confirmation matters, including motions to modify plan, motions for relief from stay and motions to dismiss, unless a creditor or party in interest can show that the fees requested are unreasonable in the particular case. The request for supplementary compensation may be included in a modified plan or requested by motion with a twenty (20) day notice and opportunity to object provided to all creditors and parties in interest.

This order is effective prospectively, and in all cases presently pending before this Court.

The Clerk shall give notice of this order to the Chapter 13 Trustees, the United States Trustee and the President of the Puerto Rico Bankruptcy Bar Association.
