

ORDER

Upon the dismissal of a Chapter 13 case wherein a Chapter 13 plan has not been confirmed, the court will retain jurisdiction for a period of twenty (20) days after the dismissal order becomes final, to determine if any professional fees are an administrative expense under 11 U.S.C. §503(b). See 11 U.S.C. §1326(a)(2). The debtor's attorney, and or any duly authorized professional, shall move the court within the twenty (20) day period for such a determination.
