In Re: Amendment to Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I Effective December 1, 2010


On December 19, 2008, as per Notice to the Bar and the Public No. 08-31, we adopted Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I, which implemented the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008. The Act excludes certain members of the National Guard and Reserves from means testing in chapter 7 bankruptcy cases that are begun in the three-year period beginning December 19, 2008.

Interim Rule 1007-I included time deadlines contained in Bankruptcy Rule 1007. One of those deadlines will be amended effective December 1, 2010 unless Congress acts to the contrary. The amendment will extend the time to file the statement of completion of a course in personal financial management in a chapter 7 case filed by an individual debtor from 45 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors to 60 days after the first date set for the meeting.
