ORDER

When the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act") was enacted into law on April 20, 2005, the Judicial Conference of the United States prepared Interim Bankruptcy Rules for cases filed on or after October 17, 2005 (the "Interim Rules") to implement the Act. This Court adopted these Interim Rules in General Order 05-04.

The Supreme Court of the United States has submitted to the United States Congress new and amended Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure ("the Bankruptcy Rules") which supercede the Interim Rules. These Bankruptcy Rules became effective on December 1, 2008. Accordingly General Order 05-04 shall stand vacated as of December 1, 2008.
