
Notice to the Bar and the Public

In Re: Substantive Consolidation

Consolidation of bankruptcy cases affects the docketing, claim filing, and noticing procedures of two or more cases which will be treated as a single case. These functions are under the purview of the clerk of the court and must be coordinated upon the filing of a motion for substantive consolidation, to avoid any delay in implementing the consolidation after the order is entered.

Therefore, when a motion for substantive consolidation is filed, the movant is required to immediately notify the clerk or his designee of the filing of the motion, and to meet with him or his designee to coordinate the docketing, claim filing, and noticing procedures to be followed once the consolidation order is entered.
