**GENERAL ORDER**

This General Order supercedes General Order No. 10-03. Upon the filing of a motion for leave to consign funds, the Clerk is ordered to proceed in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 7067-1 and the following supplementary procedure:

1. **Form of Consignment**

(a) Requests for leave to consign funds with the court will be made through the filing of a motion. The Clerk will accept funds for consignment only after the court enters an order authorizing such consignment.

2. **Earning of Interest and Registry Fee Assessment**

**Interpleader Funds -(Prefix 300)**

(a) All deposits of three thousand one (\$3001.00) dollars or greater will be deposited into interest bearing time deposit accounts.

(b) Individual accounts will be opened for each case.

(c) The applicable registry fee computation and assessment thereof will be in accordance with 28 USC§1930(b) (19). The fee will be collected and deposited with the U.S. Treasury, by the Clerk, on a monthly basis, or at the time funds are disbursed pursuant to a court order.

3. **Non- interest bearing Account -(690-00001-5)**

This registry checking account will be maintained to deposit amounts up to three thousand (\$3,000.00) dollars, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. Upon reaching the maximum amount on deposit as hereby stated, the Clerk shall order the purchase of a time deposit account in trust for the specific case, therefore transferring the consigned funds into an interest bearing account as listed in item two (2) above.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




