
GENERAL ORDER

Beginning next Tuesday, October 10th, 2017, the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico will be accepting conventional paper filings during the hours from 9:00 a.m. through 2:00 p.m. In light of the passage of Hurricane María through Puerto Rico Wednesday, September 20th, 2017, and the lack of electrical power and internet service in many areas of the island, it is determined that electronic filing may create an undue hardship and thus, attorneys may file documents conventionally under P. R. LBR 5005-4(c) until further notice. The filing in paper constitutes a representation and certification by the party doing so that filing electronically creates an undue hardship. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9011.

In accordance to P. R. LBR 5081-1, when filing conventionally any required fee, must be paid in cash, credit card, cashier's check, or money order payable to: "Clerk, U.S. Bankruptcy Court". The Clerk will not accept personal checks or credit cards of current debtors.
