AMENDED ORDER EXTENDING GENERAL ORDER


Due to the passage of hurricane Fiona through Puerto Rico on September 18, 2022, and the lack of electrical power and internet service in many areas of the island, the court issued General Order 22-03 by which all filing dates and other deadlines were extended until September 28, 2022. In view of the continued lack of electrical power and internet service,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all filing dates and other deadlines set out in the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Puerto Rico Local Bankruptcy Rules and the orders of the court are now extended or tolled, as may be appropriate, until Wednesday, October 5, 2022. Notwithstanding this extension, a judge may direct a filing date that is not within the scope of this order. Also, a party may seek further extension if deemed appropriate.

Due dates set by statute or rule that confer jurisdiction, such as those for notices of appeal, are unaffected by this order. The filing dates for those documents remain as stated in the statute or rule that confers jurisdiction.


