IN RE: MODIFICATION OF THE POLICY ON MANDATORY USE OF FACE MASKS IN THE JOSÉ V. TOLEDO UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE IN OLD SAN JUAN

Please be advised that, effective Thursday, October 6, 2022, all employees and visitors, including but not limited to members of the Bar, press, and public, will not be required to wear a face mask while in public areas and spaces at the José V. Toledo United States Courthouse in Old San Juan. The use of masks in the courtrooms for in-person hearings will be as follows:

Circuit Court of Appeals – mandatory use for everyone in the courtroom, except for the judges and the parties speaking at the podium;

District Court - consistent with the Court's *Third Amended Protocol for In-Person Hearings and Trials*; and,

Bankruptcy Court – at the discretion of the presiding judge.
